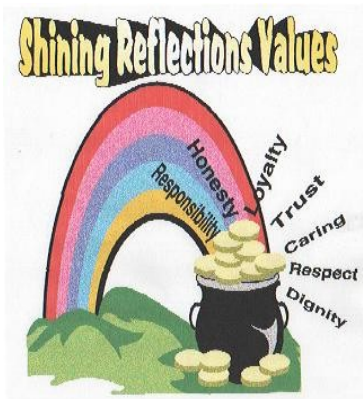

### **Vocational training Program: (BVR and BWC)**

Fee for Service with referral (in-house and community work assessments and work adjustments, job coaching, placement, retention and follow up)

### **Peer Mentoring: (CCMHR SB)**

Helping people help themselves, assigning a Peer to assist with recovery goals (Apple Grove Group).

### **Progressive Attitudes (CCMHR SB)**

Steps to recovery, socialization, life and job skills, employment, education, and community inclusion.

### **Life skills**

Self esteem, stress, coping skills, budgeting, building character, dealing with worry and anger, mental health education, parenting, & cooking.

### **Education**

WMR, BRIDGES, Network of Care Internet site, Basic education tutoring, and GED/ABLE classes available through Columbiana County Adult Ed

### **Job skills**

Value of work, maintenance training, clerical training, computer classes, getting along with others, interview skills, career choice, job search skills, work etiquette and resumes.
